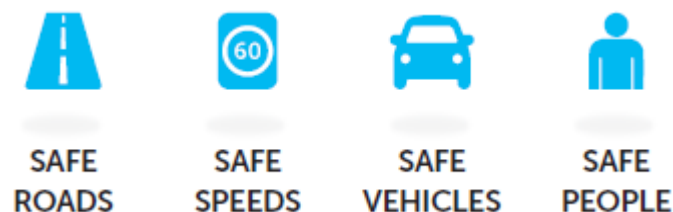




TOWARDS ZERO ROAD SAFETY AWARDS

On 26th August 2015, the Victorian Road Safety Partnership, consisting of the Transport Accident Commission (TAC), VicRoads, Victoria Police, the Department of Justice and the Department of Health & Human Services, will be hosting its 2nd Towards Zero Road Safety Leadership Symposium. The Partnership is seeking the support and assistance of leaders and the community to help Victoria reach its vision of zero deaths and serious injuries on our roads.

As a part of the event, the Partnership would like to recognise leadership excellence under the following elements of Towards Zero:



The Partnership invites anyone in the community from the public or private sectors to make a submission for an outstanding best practice initiative that has helped advance road safety and/or reduce road trauma. A winning entry will be selected under each of the four categories of Safe Roads, Safe Speeds, Safe Vehicles and Safe People. The winners will be announced at the Towards Zero Road Safety Leadership Symposium Awards Dinner on 26th August 2015 and each winner will receive a trophy and \$500 prize money.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Anyone from the community in the public or private sectors that have implemented a road safety initiative between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2014 in Victoria* are eligible to enter.

**National companies are eligible to enter, however, the initiative must have road safety benefits for their Victorian branch.*

Each entry must contain the following information:

1. Applicant details
 - a. Name
 - b. Position
 - c. Organisation
 - d. Work and mobile numbers
 - e. Email address
2. Category you are entering (Safe Roads, Safe Speeds, Safe Vehicles or Safe People – for more information to help determine which category to enter your initiative, please visit www.tac.vic.gov.au/road-safety/the-safe-system)
3. Initiative details including
 - a. Name
 - b. Objective
 - c. Summary of the initiative (no more than 1,000 words) – including details on:
 - i. what the road safety issue was
 - ii. what the initiative entailed
 - iii. measures of success
 - iv. keys elements that contributed to the success of the initiative
 - v. road safety benefits
 - vi. date the initiative was implemented
 - vii. indicative cost of initiative
 - viii. how this initiative could be taken up by others
4. Any other supporting documentation

HOW TO SUBMIT

CLOSING DATE

Entries must be received by the TAC by 5pm on Monday 10th August 2015.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Each entry will be judged on:

- How the initiative can help Victoria move Towards Zero deaths and serious injuries on the roads
- Evidence of road safety benefits
- Potential road safety impact
- Innovation
- Cost benefit
- How this initiative can be taken up by others

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Initiatives must have been implemented between 1st January 2012 and 31st December 2014.
2. Initiatives must have been implemented in Victoria, or if the initiative is national, there must be road safety benefits for its Victorian branch.
3. Each entry must contain applicant details, category the initiative is being entered into, initiative details and any supporting documentation as outlined under entry requirements.
4. Entrants may only submit an individual entry once – the same initiative cannot be entered into multiple categories.
5. The TAC reserves the right to re-allocate an entry where it does not fit the criteria for its nominated category.
6. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. Winners receive \$500 and a trophy.
8. Entries close on Monday 10th August 2015.
9. Late and hard copy entries will not be considered.
10. The winners of the 2015 Towards Zero Road Safety Awards will be announced on Wednesday 26th August 2015 at the Towards Zero Road Safety Leadership Symposium Awards Dinner at the RACV Club, Melbourne.
